- ◆ Office Hours
- ◆ GTA Office Hours

Online

- ◆ Recorded Lecture
- ◆ Email Q&A
- ◆ No Office Hours
- ◆ GTA email

- ◆ Presently in trial mode
- ◆ Requires uta.edu email and VPN
- ◆ Allows live streaming and recording for later viewing

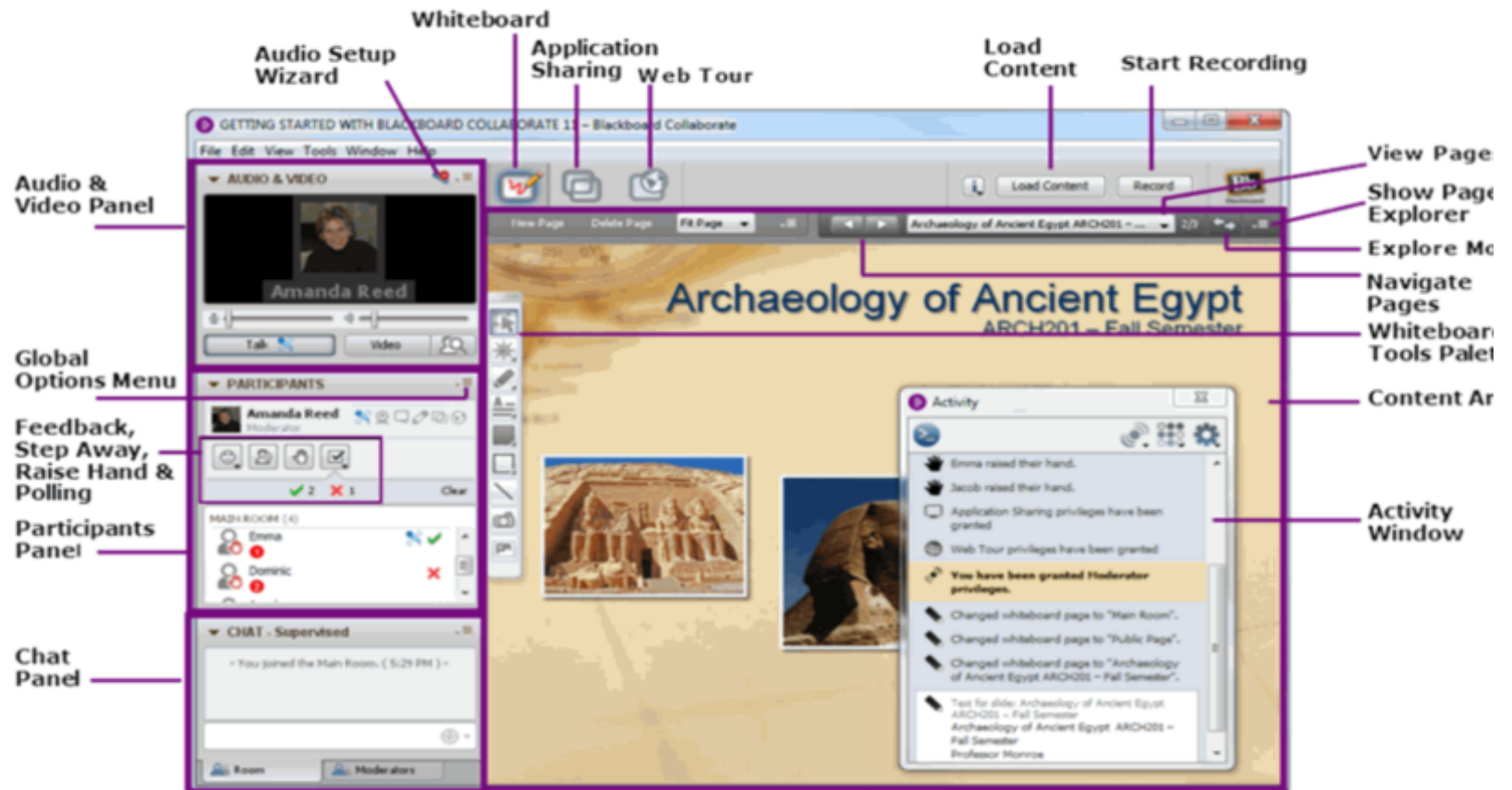

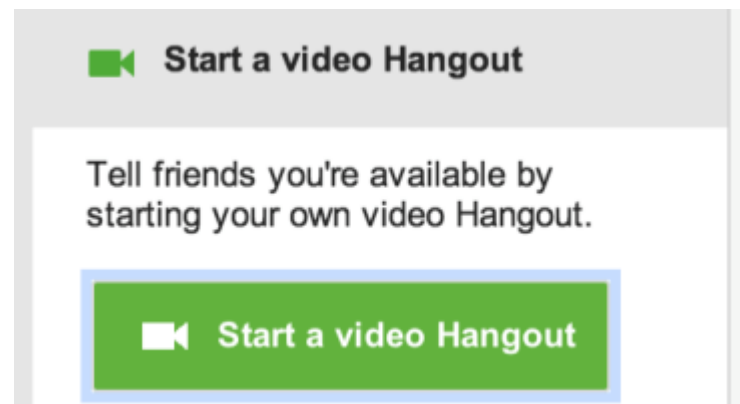
